REFLECT & RESPOND

THE LORD'S SUPPER is the act of remembering Jesus for what he accomplished by dying on the cross for our sins. Jesus asked his followers to remember that his body was broken and his blood was shed as he took the punishment for our sin.

You don't have to be a member of Turning Point to participate. If you have accepted Jesus Christ as your Lord then you are welcome to join us in celebrating the Lord's Table. But the Bible gives us two warnings. First, we should not do this in an unworthy manner. Please take time to pray and prepare your hearts. Confess any sin you are aware of and begin to focus your thoughts on the Lord. Secondly, the Bible is clear that this ceremony is for Christians, so if you are not a Christian yet, we would ask that you refrain from taking the elements, unless today you desire to commit yourself to become a follower of Jesus.

Becoming a Christian is an act of surrendering your life completely to God, confessing your belief that you need forgiveness, that Jesus came to this earth to die for your sin, that he rose again from the dead and that he is coming again. You don't have to understand all of the Bible, but you need a sincere desire to become a follower of Jesus, doing your best to learn what pleases him and committing yourself to a life of loving obedience. If you would like to know more about becoming a follower of Jesus please talk with a Christian friend or one of the pastors. Please pick up a free Bible at the Info Table in the back. Our website also has info on how to become a Christian (see "Resources" tab).

PLEASE FEEL FREE TO PARTICIPATE IN ANY OF THESE AREAS:

1. The Lord's supper is for anyone who believes in Jesus Christ as Lord. You don't have to be a member of TPC. There are 2 tables with bread and cups (grape juice) for you to celebrate the Lord's supper. When you are ready come forward using the center aisles and eat a piece of bread and drink from individual cups. Feel free to find a place to stop and pray. Use the side aisles to return to your seat. (There are small waste baskets along each wall to dispose of your cups.)
2. Prayer Area: There will be a pastor or other leader ready to pray for you if you desire prayer for yourself or for someone else. Please feel free to approach them with your requests.
3. Offering: Take a moment at the offering box to thank God for his many blessings and to worship him by giving back a portion of what he has given you. You can also put your "Feedback" form in the box.
4. Stay in your seat and reflect on how you will respond to what you have heard today. Enjoy the music. Write a response on your "Growing Point".

HIS KIDS CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

9:00 service Nursery & Child care up to 4th grade.

11:00 service all classes available

Note to Parents: Children's staff are adults who passed background checks. For security purposes, all children in all His Kids classes must be checked in at the check-in table located in the lobby. Please do this before service. Children in each age-bracket will experience age-appropriate Sunday school programs. For more information about His Kids see the parent brochure at the check-in table.

His Kids Nursery class (ages 1 thru 3 years old) : Children in this age group meet in His Kids Room 2 (lower level). Nursery opens at 8:55 for first service and 10:55 for second service. You will be given a pager at the room when you drop off your child. The "Gospel Light" lesson begins after children are dismissed from the children's sermon in the main room. Adults picking up a child from nursery must bring the sticker and the pager received at time of check-in. Please respect our wellness policy by keeping your child out of the nursery if he/she exhibits any symptom of illness.

Preschool/Kindergarten classes (4 years old through kindergarten): Children in this age group meet downstairs in room 1.

Primary (1st and 2nd grades): Children in this age group meet in His Kids Room 6 & 7 (upper level) directly following the children's message. Adults picking up a child from this class must bring the sticker received at time of check-in.

Intermediate (3rd grade through 5th grade): Children in this age group meet in room 8 & 9 (upper level) directly following the children's message. Children will be dismissed to find their parents after this class, which ends at the same time as the main service.

Parents of Infants: The Mothers' Only Room is located upstairs (Room #4). This room is designed to provide privacy and a quiet, comfortable place where mothers can continue to see and hear the service while feeding their babies.

Middle School: (Grades 6-8) meet in the conference room (upper level) directly following the children's message.
