We are in the midst of the holidays...

Hanukkah Christmas, New Year and praying for the rains this winter to be plentiful.

Since this summer we have had a busy three months full of activities for youth, soldiers and youth leaders. We are so thankful to see the work of God in the lives of many who are being challenged to grow and mature in our Lord Yeshua and bearing good fruit.

# What happened lately?

Soldiers' Conference - September 27-28 - our first soldiers conference this year was called "Touch the Wall" which means in military slang - "made it to half way". We talked about the difficulties of the day to day routine with the grind and stress the soldiers are facing each day. We shared teaching and insights on the importance of staying spiritually healthy and connected to Christ and the Body during this challenging time.

The responses of the soldiers were encouraging as the topic was important and relevant for them.

Youth Leaders Seminar – October 11 – our first session with the youth leaders was about time management. We had a guest speaker share about the importance of managing our time correctly both personally and in the ministry.

'Arrows" Graduation – October 17 – we celebrated the graduation of the 11 weekprogram for 17 participants at Yad Hashmona. Many Parents, Pastors, Youth leaders and friends attended. The graduates had an



opportunity share their testimonies with the guests and to present their personal identity projects and apologetics research.

Youth Conferences – November 8-9 – our first national youth conference this school year. There were around 360 teens from all over the country, and together with youth leaders, volunteers and staff close to 400 people. Our topic was "Shalem" ("Whole").

It was such a blessing for us to see so many youth coming to study the word, spend time in community and fellowship, and have fun together.

We were very thankful to God for the good weather so that we could have the conference outdoors, considering that we would not be able to fit so many people inside.

Junior Leadership Training - November 15-16 and December 20-21 - we had a group of youth recommended by their local congregations take part in a Junior Leadership Program that will train 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade youth to be active servants and helpers in their congregations and to be a part of the Netivah Junior High Team.

Junior High – November 29-30 – last month we had conference for the Junior High teens (13-14 years old). The conference was called "Hineni" (here am I). We spoke about God's calling for our lives and our response to say "here I am, ready and willing to be used". As part of the staff preparation for the Junior High conference we had the Junior Leadership Team on staff with us.

### Soldiers' Conference "SOLO" -

**December 13-14** – at the conference we talked about the struggle of loneliness during our military service, the natural need to belong, keeping pure and the danger in relationship between guys and girls.

Please pray with us for a solution in the near future. One of the options that we are praying about is to build a "Tent City" on the land that is currently being farmed near our office at the Baptist Village. - <u>4 x 4 Vehicle</u> We continue to have a need for a 4x4 vehicle. This summer we rented a 4x4 pickup truck in order get to hard to access places during the Sea to Sea hike and "Chetzim" ("Arrows") pre-military discipleship programs.
