LAST WEEK'S SERMON

Grace Appearing

In *Titus 2:11–14*, Paul reminds the church that Christianity is not merely about what we believe, but about how grace reshapes the way we live. The big idea of this passage is clear: **because God's grace has appeared in Jesus Christ, we are called to say no to sin and yes to Jesus.**

A. The Incarnation (v. 11)

Grace is not an abstract idea; it has appeared in a Person. In the incarnation, God's grace and salvation are revealed through Jesus Christ. He is the **source of our salvation** and the visible expression of **God's grace** to a lost world. The coming of Christ proves that grace originates with God, not with us. Salvation begins not with human effort, but with divine initiative.

B. The Transformation (vv. 12–13)

The same grace that saves us also changes us. Grace trains us to renounce ungodliness and worldly passions and to live lives marked by self-control, righteousness, and godliness. Christ is the **source of our self-control** and the **source of our sanctification**. As we wait with hope for His glorious return, grace shapes us into a people whose lives reflect the holiness of the Savior we are longing to see.

C. The Atonement (v. 14)

At the heart of this passage stands the cross. Jesus gave Himself for us, becoming the **source of our redemption**, rescuing us from lawlessness and purifying us as His own possession. His atoning work also becomes the **source of our motivation**, we live zealously for good works not to earn salvation, but because we have been redeemed by grace.

Conclusion

Titus 2:11–14 calls us to respond rightly to grace. Because grace has appeared in Christ, we are empowered to say **no to sin and yes to Jesus**. The incarnation reveals God's saving grace, the transformed life displays self-control and sanctification, and the atonement secures our redemption and fuels our devotion. Grace does not leave us where we are, it saves us, shapes us, and sends us forward for the glory of Christ.
