LAST WEEK'S SERMON

Wisdom the World Cannot Know (1 Corinthians 2:6–16)

In 1 Corinthians 2:6–16, Paul teaches that true spiritual maturity is shaped not by the wisdom of this age, but by the wisdom of God revealed through the Holy Spirit. While the world prizes intellect, influence, and power, Paul reminds the church that such wisdom is temporary and ultimately incapable of producing genuine understanding of God. The rulers of this age demonstrated the limits of human wisdom by crucifying the Lord of glory, proving that intellect alone cannot perceive God's redemptive purposes. For this reason, believers must, **1. Reject the illusion that human wisdom leads to spiritual maturity**, learning instead to measure truth through God's revelation rather than cultural approval.

God's wisdom, though hidden from the world, was planned before the ages and graciously revealed through the Spirit. What no eye could see or mind imagine has now been made known, not through human reasoning, but through divine revelation. This wisdom is received only by those who humbly submit to the Spirit's work, reminding us to, **2. Receive God's truth through the Spirit with humility and faith**, trusting that understanding is a gift from God rather than an achievement of human effort.

Paul emphasizes that believers have received not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, so that they may understand what has been freely given to them in Christ. Spiritual growth, therefore, is not sustained by intellect alone, but by ongoing dependence on the Spirit's teaching and illumination. The Christian life requires believers to, **3. Rely daily on the Spirit to shape your understanding**, allowing Him to influence not only what they believe, but how they interpret life, suffering, and obedience.

Finally, Paul declares the stunning truth that believers have been given "the mind of Christ." This does not mean knowing everything, but learning to see life through the lens of the cross, valuing humility over pride, obedience over recognition, and faithfulness over worldly success. As the Spirit forms Christ's mindset within us, we are called to, **4. Reflect the mind of Christ in how you live, choose, and endure**, even when God's wisdom appears foolish to the world.

True wisdom, Paul shows us, is not discovered by human brilliance but revealed by God's Spirit, rooted in the cross, and expressed through lives increasingly shaped by Christ Himself.
