LAST WEEK'S SERMON

Measured By Faithfulness

1 Corinthians 4:1-7

1. Seeing ourselves as stewards increases reverence.

Paul corrects the Corinthians inflated view of leadership by reminding them that ministers are servants under Christ and stewards entrusted with His revealed truth. We do not own the gospel; we manage what belongs to Another. That reality humbles us and deepens our sense of sacred responsibility. When we understand that we are caretakers, not creators of divine truth, it produces reverence, dependence, and careful obedience rather than pride or performance.

2. Know that your simple calling is to be faithful.

The single requirement God gives for stewards is faithfulness, not success or applause. Faithfulness means steady obedience with what God has entrusted to us, leaving the results in His hands. Whether the season feels fruitful or barren, our responsibility remains the same: obey, endure, and remain trustworthy. This truth frees us from both discouragement in small outcomes and pride in large ones, anchoring our identity in obedience rather than visible results.

3. Christ sees secret faithfulness.

Paul reminds us that human judgment is limited and incomplete, but the Lord sees perfectly. One day He will bring hidden motives into the light and reward what was done in sincerity. That means unseen prayers, quiet obedience, and hidden sacrifices are never wasted. We are liberated from living for public approval because Christ's evaluation is the only one that ultimately matters and His commendation will be perfectly just and gracious.

4. Receive everything as grace and let pride fall away.

Paul dismantles boasting by asking what we have that we did not receive. Every ability, opportunity, and spiritual blessing is a gift from God. When we recognize that all we are and have is grace, pride loses its footing. Gratitude replaces comparison, and humility becomes the natural posture of the heart. Living in continual awareness of grace reshapes how we see ourselves and keeps us grounded before the Giver of every good gift.
