

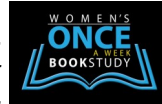

LAST WEEK'S SERMON

Identity, Wisdom, and Unity in Conflict

1 Corinthians 6:1–8

In this passage, Paul confronts believers who were taking their disputes before unbelieving courts, revealing a deeper issue of identity and spiritual immaturity. Instead of living as those transformed by Christ, they were handling conflict with the same mindset as the world. Paul reminds them that who we are in Christ must shape how we respond to conflict, calling us to pursue peace, humility, and unity rather than self-justification and personal victory.

1. **Our identity should shape our behavior.** As those redeemed by Christ, we are called to handle conflict in a way that reflects His character, not the patterns of the world.
2. **God has already given us everything we need to pursue peace.** Through His Word, His Spirit, and the wisdom found within the church, God has equipped us to resolve conflict in a way that honors Him.
3. **Conflict reveals our level of spiritual maturity.** How we respond when wronged exposes whether we are walking in the flesh or growing in Christlike humility and grace.

Choose relational unity over personal victory. Rather than insisting on our rights, we are called to value unity in the body of Christ, even if it means being wronged for the sake of peace. Ultimately, this passage calls us to live differently, not as people driven by pride and self-interest, but as those shaped by the cross, where Jesus Himself chose sacrifice over self-justification for our sake.
