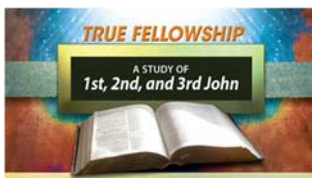

ELDERS CORNER

The reality of sin.

The Bible teaches us that we all have sin!

- a- We are born with sin: **Psalm 51:5**
- b- Everything we do is stained by sin: **Isaiah 64:6**
- c- Even without original sin, we are still guilty by our actions of sinning: **Romans 3:23**
- d- We are all condemned as sinners and face God's just and righteous punishment: **Romans 6:23**

How does the suggestion that we have no sin make God a liar? Because it denies the scripture. The scripture is God's holy and inspired word! To deny the scripture is to deny the very words of God. It denies the truth of the gospel. If we deny our sin, we deny our need for a savior.

The reality of God's forgiveness.

Because we have sin, means that we need a savior! Because we need a savior, God sent His Son Jesus to become a propitiation (sacrifice of atonement) for our sin! Through our faith in Jesus as our atoning sacrifice we have our salvation and are brought into the light! Now that we are free from our slavery to sin we should not desire to live in sin any longer!

When we turn from our sin, we turn from darkness to the light! This grants us fellowship with God! Our sin is forgiven! Jesus has paid the price.

Letting the light of Jesus shine in our hearts.

When we come to Jesus we need to know that He is going to shine His light into our hearts and expose the darkness. That is not a bad thing! That is a good thing! We need God to expose our darkness with His light so that the darkness goes away. Confess your sins to God! Bring what has been hidden into the light so that the light of Jesus can make the darkness of sin go away!
