LAST WEEK'S SERMON

Faithful Where You Are

We often believe we would follow Christ more faithfully if our circumstances were different. But in 1 Corinthians 7:10–24, Paul redirects that thinking. God does not call us to chase a different life, but to honor Him in the one we already have.

Pursue reconciliation instead of separation. Honor God whenever possible. Are there relationships where you are tempted to walk away instead of working toward peace? God's design for marriage reflects His covenant faithfulness.

Be a steady witness of Christ in difficult relationships. rather than seeking escape. This means living with patience, integrity, and Christlike love, trusting that God is at work even when you cannot see it. Where has God placed you as a light, even when it's hard?

Stop waiting to become faithful. for a different life —start where you are. This means rejecting the lie that your current circumstances limit your ability to follow Christ. Instead, it means embracing today as the place where obedience begins.

Anchor your identity in Christ. not your circumstances. This means rejecting labels that compete with your identity in Him and living from the security of being redeemed and owned by Christ. What labels are you letting define you more than your identity in Christ?

Practice daily faithfulness and dependence on God.

This means beginning each day with the awareness that God is already where you are, and choosing to obey Him in that very place. What would it look like to live today aware that God is with you right where you are? God's presence transforms your current situation into a place of growth and obedience. God is not waiting for your life to change. He calls you to faithfulness right where you are.
