Many donations are then dropped off at other food distribution sites, such as Lacey and Olympia Food Bank distribution centers. Volunteers would need to be available 7:30 AM to about 9:00 AM. This can be on a reoccurring scheduled basis (for example, every Monday) or on-call to cover vacations.
