ELDERS CORNER

Last Week's Sermon

1 John 4:7-12

In a world confused about what real love is, John gives us a clear answer: "**God is love**." But this isn't a vague or sentimental idea, it's grounded in truth and demonstrated through action. Real love flows from God's nature, was revealed in the sending of His Son to die for our sins, and is meant to be reflected through our lives.

God's love is **sacrificial**, not superficial. It doesn't ignore sin, it deals with it at the cross. And it doesn't stay private, it's meant to be lived out in the way we treat one another. John shows us that when we love like God loves, the invisible God becomes visible to the world.

This passage reminds us that love is both **the evidence** of a real relationship with God and **the expression** of it. Love isn't optional for Christians, it's essential. And it begins not with our effort, but with receiving God's love ourselves.

1. When God lives in you, love should grow out of you. If your love is lacking, it may point to something missing in your walk with God.

2. You'll never love others well until you rest in how deeply God loves you. His love is not earned, it is given. Let go of striving.

3. **God wants to love others through you.** You are not just a recipient of God's love, you are a vessel of it.

4. The more you receive God's love, the more you'll be able to give it. You can't pour into others from an empty heart. You must abide in His love daily.
