LAST WEEK'S SERMON

Gifted by Grace

1 Corinthians 12:1–11 (ESV)

As we continue through 1 Corinthians, this passage reminds us that spiritual gifts are never about personal recognition. They are gracious gifts from the Holy Spirit, given to exalt Christ and strengthen His church.

1. Submit your heart to the lordship of Jesus Christ.

Every genuine work of the Holy Spirit points us to Jesus Christ and leads us into joyful submission to His authority. Before we think about spiritual gifts, we must first recognize Christ as Lord over every area of our lives.

2. Value every believer's God-given contribution.

God intentionally gives different gifts to different believers so His church can serve together in unity. Instead of comparing ourselves with others, we should celebrate God's wisdom and appreciate every faithful act of service.

3. Serve others with the gifts God has entrusted to you.

Every Christian has been equipped by the Holy Spirit to strengthen the body of Christ. Our gifts are not meant to draw attention to ourselves but to display God's grace by serving others with humility and faithfulness.

4. Faithfully Steward the Gifts God Has Chosen to Give You.

The Holy Spirit sovereignly distributes gifts according to His perfect wisdom and purpose. Rather than wishing for different abilities, we honor God by faithfully using what He has entrusted to us for His glory and the good of His people.

Spiritual gifts reveal God's grace at work through ordinary believers serving in extraordinary ways. May we keep our eyes on Christ, gladly serve His church, and faithfully steward every gift He has given until He is glorified in us.
