PREVIOUS SERMON

Worship That Reflects God **1 Corinthians 14:26–40**

Because God is a God of peace, our worship should reflect His character by strengthening His people, honoring His order, and obeying His Word.

1. Use whatever God has given you to strengthen His people.

Every gift God gives is meant to serve others, not showcase ourselves or secure recognition. Love asks whether our teaching, singing, praying, leading, or serving will help Christ's people grow stronger in faith, truth, encouragement, unity, and practical love.

2. Submit your spiritual experiences to biblical discernment

Spiritual enthusiasm does not remove our need for biblical testing, humility, and self-control. We should carefully weigh every claim, remembering that the Holy Spirit never contradicts His Word or leads His people into confusion, disorder, or uncontrolled behavior, but produces peace and mutual edification.

3. Trust God's wisdom enough to embrace His good order for His church.

God's order does not diminish anyone's worth; every believer is equally loved, saved by grace, and precious in Christ. Mature faith trusts God's wisdom even when His design challenges our culture, personal preferences, or ideas about ministry and authority in the gathered church.

4. Measure every spiritual belief, experience, and church practice by the Word of God.

Scripture, not feelings, traditions, personalities, or cultural expectations, has the final authority over Christ's church. When our experience conflicts with God's Word, true spirituality is shown by submitting to the Lord's command and allowing Scripture to correct our thinking, attitudes, choices, and church practices.

Christ is building a church that is alive in the Spirit, grounded in Scripture, eager to serve, humble in submission, and committed to strengthening others.
