REFLECT & RESPOND

THE LORD'S SUPPER is the act of remembering Jesus for what he accomplished by dying on the cross for our sins. Jesus asked his followers to remember that his body was broken and his blood was shed as he took the punishment for our sin.

You don't have to be a member of Turning Point to participate. If you have accepted Jesus Christ as your Lord then you are welcome to join us in celebrating the Lord's Table. But the Bible gives us two warnings. First, we should not do this in an unworthy manner. Please take time to pray and prepare your hearts. Confess any sin you are aware of and begin to focus your thoughts on the Lord. Secondly, the Bible is clear that this ceremony is for Christians, so if you are not a Christian yet, we would ask that you refrain from taking the elements, unless today you desire to commit yourself to become a follower of Jesus.

Becoming a Christian is an act of surrendering your life completely to God, confessing your belief that you need forgiveness, that Jesus came to this earth to die for your sin, that he rose again from the dead and that he is coming again. You don't have to understand all of the Bible, but you need a sincere desire to become a follower of Jesus, doing your best to learn what pleases him and committing yourself to a life of loving obedience.
