REFLECT & RESPOND

THE LORD'S SUPPER is the act of remembering Jesus for what he accomplished by dying on the cross for our sins. Jesus asked his followers to remember that his body was broken and his blood was shed as he took the punishment for our sin.

You don't have to be a member of Turning Point to participate. If you have accepted Jesus Christ as your Lord then you are welcome to join us in celebrating the Lord's Table. But the Bible gives us two warnings. First, we should not do this in an unworthy manner. Please take time to pray and prepare your hearts. Confess any sin you are aware of and begin to focus your thoughts on the Lord. Secondly, the Bible is clear that this ceremony is for Christians, so if you are not a Christian yet, we would ask that you refrain from taking the elements, unless today you desire to commit yourself to become a follower of Jesus.

Becoming a Christian is an act of surrendering your life completely to God, confessing your belief that you need forgiveness, that Jesus came to this earth to die for your sin, that he rose again from the dead and that he is coming again. You don't have to understand all of the Bible, but you need a sincere desire to become a follower of Jesus, doing your best to learn what pleases him and committing yourself to a life of loving obedience. HIS KIDS CHILDREN'S MINISTRY
Helping kids know and love Jesus!
The Nursery is available during 2nd service at 10:30am

Nursery (ages 1 through 3 years old): Children in this age group meet in His Kids Room 2 (lower level). Nursery opens at 10:25am for second service. The lessons begin after children are dismissed from the Main Room. Please respect our wellness policy by keeping your child out of the nursery if he/she exhibits any symptom of illness.

Classes available during 2nd service at 10:30am:

Preschool/Kindergarten: (age 4 through 1st grade): This class meets downstairs in Room 1. The class begins after children are dismissed from the Main Room - please escort your child to the classroom at that time.

2nd & 3rd grades: Children in this age group will meet in the Lobby after children are dismissed from the Main Room. They will follow their teacher up the stairs to His Kids Room 6-7 (upper level)

4th and 5th graders: Children in this age group will meet in His Kids Room 8-9 (upper level) directly when children are dismissed from the Main Room. Children will be dismissed to find their parents after this class, which ends at the same time as the main service.

Middle School: (Grades 6-8) meet in the conference room (upper level) directly following the children's message.

Note to Parents: Children's staff are adults who passed background checks. For security purposes, all children in all His Kids classes must be checked in where they will receive a name tag and a coded sticker per child. (Pagers are issued upon the parents' request.) Please do this before service. **When picking up children from the Nursery, Preschool and Primary classes, please bring the sticker received at time of check-in.** Children in each age-bracket will experience age-appropriate Sunday school programs.

Parents of Infants: The Mothers' Only Room is located upstairs (Room #4). This room is designed to provide privacy and a quiet, comfortable place where mothers can continue to see and hear the service while feeding their babies.
