Two weeks later we got word. Masa's body was found in the entry way of his apartment. He had died alone. We don't know if he actually read the booklet or opened his heart to Jesus. Only God knows. But it riveted in us the importance to make the most of every opportunity for the Gospel.

In the following weeks we saw several people respond to accept Jesus when going through various GospelShare. All of them were associated with Sophia's Blossom disability fellowship (now partnered with Joni and Friends)!
